

RESIDENTS ARE ASKED FOR ASSISTANCE DURING SNOW STORMS

The Tolland Fire Department, Inc. asks residents and businesses in Tolland to provide important assistance during snow and ice storms by complying with the following regulations in accordance with the Tolland Town Charter and Connecticut General Statutes:

- A parking ban is in effect on all public streets and municipal parking lots in Tolland between the hours of midnight and 6 a.m. from November 1st to April 15th. Parking may also be banned for during additional hours if a significant snow event is forecast or in progress. Vehicles left on town roads which impede snow plowing efforts or otherwise create a hazard can be towed at the owner's expense and a fine may be imposed.
- Residents and business owners are required to clear snow and ice from sidewalks and fire hydrants in front of their premises within 24 hours of the conclusion of a storm.
- Snow and ice may not be plowed, blown or shoveled into the street. This practice presents a hazard to passing motorists and may contribute to unsafe road conditions.

The cooperation of all residents is very important to public safety. Failure to observe these precautions prevents streets from being properly maintained and may hinder fire apparatus, ambulances and fire department volunteers as they respond to emergency calls. .
