## Residents Reminded of Duties During Snow Storms

The Town of Tolland Department of Public Safety would like to remind town residents and business owners that during snow and ice storms they need to comply with the following regulations in accordance with the town charter and Connecticut General Statutes:

- A parking ban is in effect in town during snow and ice storms. Vehicles left on town roads which impede snow plowing efforts or otherwise create a hazard can be towed and a fine may be imposed.
- Residents and business owners are required to clear snow and ice from sidewalks and fire hydrants in front of their premises within 24 hours of the conclusion of a storm.
- Snow and ice may not be plowed, blown or shoveled into the street. This practice presents a hazard to motorists.

Residents and businesses are asked to observe these regulations whenever snow or ice requires the use of snow removal equipment. Failure to observe these rules prevents streets from being properly maintained and also poses a hazard to pedestrians and motorists.
